Vocal Improvisation and Story Singing

3 Day Residential Workshop Queen's Birthday Weekend June 11 – 14, 2010

An opportunity for singing and renewal in a peaceful setting

Participants are involved in vocal improvisation and the telling and singing of personal stories. We use harmony, text, rhythm, ensemble and solo work to create improvised songs. By emphasising vocal qualities, the use of metaphor and suitable musical structures, the songs come to reflect a range of human experiences. You can expect to develop your spontaneity, creativity and vocal flexibility.

Pre-requisites: Attendance at the Creative Voice Tuesday Evening Advanced Vocal Improvisation and Story Singing Group or equivalent. You must be able to hold and devise harmonies in the moment, have confidence and experience in vocal improvisation, and be willing to sing and experiment with others.

This is a 3 hour drive from Melbourne, in the direction of Hamilton. Detailed instructions on how to get there will be provided on enrolment.
